

This is a list of tools and materials recommended for use in the installation of these stair nosings. These tools and materials are not provided by Balco, Inc.


- A. 3/16" Drill Bits (for concrete)

- D. Bostik 1100 FS (or equal)




- 1. Stair Nosing

- <sup>1</sup> Fasteners supplied are two step expansion anchors (shown) for concrete stair tread installation.


#### PROCEDURES:


To ensure proper installation of the stair nosings, relevel all worn or dished stair treads using a quick setting, Portland cement based, self-leveling compound. In addition, fill any gap between the front lip or the stair nosing and the stair tread. Balco, Inc. recommends the following repoair mortars: Thoroc 1060, Emaco T-415, Sika 123 or an equivalent.











#### **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE:**

To ensure optimum performance, Balco, Inc. recommends cleaning Illumitread Stair Nosings with a non-alkaline cleaner and a soft cloth or sponge and drying as needed. Recommend cleaning a minimum of once a year or more often, depending on use and environment.


