into new office space for the Bergey Creative


Group marketing firm, the team literally
jumped at the chance.

"We loved this challenge because we could play such a vital role in reclaiming a historic structure in our hometown from certain demise," according to Dennis Gehman, president,
Gehman Custom Builder. "To give this building a new life, we had to add in a new HVAC system, computer and communications wiring, an in-house stereo system and a message delivery system. All with hidden wiring to preserve the quiet design of the original chapel."

Glenn Ritter, to maintain the original feel of the chapel, they also added in newer products

that would take the structure comfortably into the future. New plumbing and electrical systems were installed, a large custom made winding oak wood staircase with wrought iron railings was added to access a new mezzanine and the exterior walls were stabilized.

Outside the building, while the original window trims and configurations were maintained, Gehman and his team replaced the window units with low-maintenance, energy-efficient Simonton windows. Custom-made in the style of the original windows, the new Simonton units were made to fit into the existing brick walls of the chapel.

"The window style in the main area really defines the Gothic feel of the structure, so it was incredibly important to replicate their design while adding upgraded features," says Gehman. "We used Gothic, Casement, Double Hung and Circle windows in this project. All of them feature Low E/Argon-filled glass for superior energy efficiency.


"To gain privacy in the six offices, we ordered obscure glass in some units on the bottom portion and completely obscure glass in other units. Inside and out, the white vinyl frames add tremendously to the overall look of the building while giving the new owners fewer maintenance hassles. The windows are truly one of the most visually appealing aspects that define the chapel ... and now the BC Group can rely on them for years of energy-efficient service."
