

- ► Gauges: 26ga and 24ga standard, 22ga optional


Rated ASTM E-1592 (Mini-Batten only)

(applies to 1" Mini-Batten only)

▶ 12", 16", or 18" panel coverage, 1" or $1\frac{1}{2}$ " high rib utilizing a narrow batten cap

UL 580, Class 90 Wind Uplift, Construction Number 430 over 5/8" plywood deck

- ▶ Concealed clip designed to accommodate thermal movement
- Applies over plywood substrate with 30 pound felt underlayment
- ▶ Available for curved applications (see back for curving specifications)







PANEL CLIPS






MINI-BATTEN (11/2" standing seam height)

GENERAL INFORMATION

▶ Slope

The minimum recommended slope for Mini-Batten roof panel is 3:12.

▶ Substructure

The recommended substrate is $\frac{5}{8}$ " plywood with a 30 pound felt moisture barrier. To avoid panel distortion, use a properly aligned and uniform substructure.

NOTE: Mini-Batten roof panels are not recommended for use over open structural framing.

▶ Coverage

Mini-Batten panels are available in 12", 16", or 18" widths in either 1" or $1^{1}/_{2}$ " rib heights.

▶ Length

Minimum factory cut length is 5'-0". Maximum recommended panel length is 45'-0". Longer panels require additional consideration in packaging, shipping, and erection. Please consult Metal Sales for recommendations.

▶ Fasteners

The fastener selection guide should be consulted for choosing the proper fastener for specific applications. Quantity and type of fastener must meet necessary loading and code requirements.

NOTE: All panels are subject to surface distortion due to improperly applied fasteners. Overdriven fasteners will cause stress and induce oil canning across the face of the panel at or near the point of attachment.

► Availability

Finishes: Acrylic Coated Galvalume®, MS Colorfast45®, or various Kynar 500 (PVDF) colors.

Gauges: 26ga and 24ga standard, 22ga optional

▶ Oil Canning

Oil canning is not a cause for rejection. Heavier gauges and narrower widths minimize oil canning.

▶ Loading Information

Mini-Batten 1" must be installed over solid substrate. Panel attachment to substrate at fixed locations must be checked for drag loads. Please contact Metal Sales Technical Services for the latest ASTM E-1592 uplift design loads (available on Mini-Batten 1" high, 12" and 16" wide 24 Gauge). Mini-Batten 1.5" must be installed over solid substrate. Panel fixity must be checked for drag loads.
