




Renovation projects require vision. And that's exactly what HGTV host Pat Simpson had

when he saw an old, one-story concrete block home sitting on the banks of Lake Jackson in Georgia. He envisioned a weekend getaway spot for his family that required minimum maintenance and maximum relaxation.

When Pat Simpson saw the aging lakeside cabin for the first time, he knew it had

bedrooms and three full baths. A second story loft area overlooks a new fireplace in the family room. And, for those evenings when it's just too nice to stay indoors, a columned front porch has been added, showcasing the lakefront views.

"When we're inside we can see the lake from almost every room," says Simpson. "The connection with the outdoors made the selection of windows extremely important for us. We chose Simonton ProFinish[®] windows because of their low maintenance

promise. The location was idyllic and restful. The home, although in poor shape, had potential. How did he know? As the host of HGTV's popular *Before and After* television show, Simpson has seen a good number of home transformations.

"There's always one key element that grabs hold of someone who buys a home needing massive remodeling or renovation work," says Simpson, a former contractor. "For our family, it was the incredible lakefront views we believed would be available if trees were trimmed back and the house was made taller."

appeal and the strong energy efficiency value they offer."

"We installed several mulled units in the house to maximize views. With that much glass you have to invest in windows that will work for you — not against you. The Simonton ProFinish[®] windows we selected meet ENERGY STAR[®] requirements, so we're assured that our home will stay cooler in the summer and retain the sun's warmth during the winter."

Now a 2,030-square-foot getaway home that draws admiring glances from neighbors, Simpson's lakefront retreat has fulfilled his vision. "We transformed this property by clearing some trees and adding a new dock," says Simpson. "This is now a perfect weekend house."
